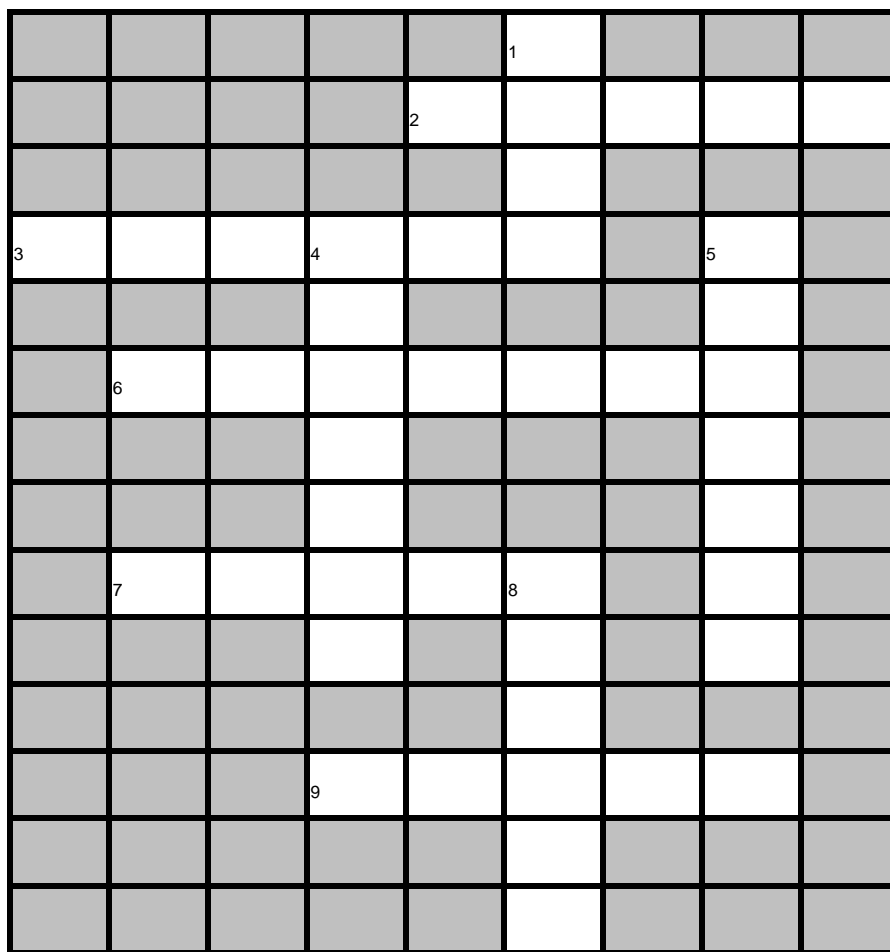


# Our Solar System

1. This planet has two moons, and the largest volcano in our solar system, Olympus Mons.
4. This blue planet has eight moons, and six rings. The giant storm that is visible on its surface is called "The Great Dark Spot"
5. This planet has no moons. Extreme temperatures make it boiling hot during the day and freezing cold at night.
6. This ringed planet has more moons than any other at 30.

2. The only planet with living organisms.
3. This planet has three moons and is the only in our solar system that spins on its side.
6. The largest planet has 28 moons and no solid surface being made up entirely of hydrogen and water.
7. This moonless planet has the hottest average temperature of all the planets and is almost the exact same size as Earth
9. This planet is so small its only moon is almost equal to it in size and scientists have tried to have it reclassified as a comet.
